## Question: Playing Handicap – Why 95%

- Provides Equity

Scratch Golfer HI 0.5

Best 8 of 20 score differentials

-2.3	0.5	2.3
------	-----	-----

1.8

Bogey Golfer HI 22

Best 8 of 20 score differentials

17.3	22	25
------	----	----

4.7

- The larger the field, the larger the odds
- Analysis of 1,000s of scores
- 95% provides the most balanced chances for ALL golfers
- Not required in matchplay 1-1

Question:  
Playing Handicap  
When applied.

- Playing handicap

A *Playing Handicap* is calculated as follows:

$$\text{Playing Handicap} = \text{Course Handicap} \times \text{handicap allowance}$$

The calculated *Playing Handicap* is rounded to the nearest whole number, with .5 rounded upwards.

- Determined by the format of the competition
- Used for Results Purposes
- Play to Course Handicap

- All scores that satisfy the conditions in 2.1 must be returned for handicap purposes
  - Authorised format of play
  - With another player
  - By the Rules of Golf
  - Course with Course Rating and Slope Rating
