Competitions & Fixtures



- Junior Competitions scheduled from 11.30 each Saturday throughout the season (All qualifying for h/caps)
- Open to Girls / Boys each week – All Tee categories
- Mixed Playing draw done by JLO each week
- Combination of Stroke & Stableford competitions
- Fully computerised results processed same week-end for h/cap purposes (Club v1). Results linked to HowDidIDo
- 8 'Trophy' events – including Junior Club Champ (36 holes)
- Order-of-Merit running throughout the season
- Junior Winter League 12 hole comp (best 8 scores) running all winter
- End of Season Presentation evening

Junior Handicaps



- Young players & beginners will commence from the blue tees & will submit 2 cards for handicap assessment
- The JLO will assess a player's development & decide when a player can move from Blue > Yellow, Yellow > White tees
- Competitions are in place for Blue & Yellow players
- A club handicap system is in operation for all juniors who sit outside the CONGU system
- When a player is deemed suitable to move to the CONGU system, a playing round with JLO will be required.
- A CONGU handicap will then be applied
- A junior with a handicap of 18 is allowed to play in adult competitions

Mizuno DCGUJ Order of Merit

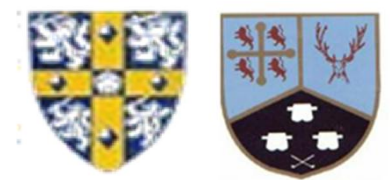


- DCGUJ Order of Merit series is made up of 11 Qualifying events (Junior Opens) across Co. Durham

- Qualification for team is 28 h/cap or less with selection based on form in both league games & junior comps
- All games commence from 5.00pm, home games on Thursday nights. Away games on various nights
- Additional cup comps: 5-man team, PD Cowell, County Foursomes & RBL Poppy Appeal (National)

Code of Conduct

Junior Coaching



- Our club professional Chris Cole delivers free coaching to Junior Members on Sat mornings from 10.00~11.00
- All aspects covered from technical work, through to Rules & Golf Etiquette
- The sessions are available to non-members too so please feel free to bring along a friend
- The 10.00am Saturday slot is perfect for warming up under the technical guidance of our Pro, being just prior to the weekly Junior competitions scheduled from 11:30 each Saturday

Junior Coaching Schedule 2019



- Coaching runs on a 6 week rotation followed by a skills challenge week where progress can be assessed
- It will consist of a 20 minute warm up where the player practices their golf swing. Then 20 minutes of focussed coaching as follows:

Week	Activity
1	Short Game – Pitching/Chipping
2	Mini Course
3	Putting
4	Irons
5	Bunkers
6	Woods
7	Skills Challenge

The coaching session is ended with a warm down and tidy up of the practice area
