Open Competitions Terms and Conditions

- Entry fee must be paid with on line entry and/or accompany completed entry form
- All players must have active handicaps
- Cheques to be made payable to P.M.G.C. and forwarded to Secretary's office, Peterborough Milton Golf Club, Milton Ferry, Peterborough, PE6 7AG
- Bank Transfer to ACCOUNT NAME PMGC LTD. SORT CODE 20-67-37
ACCOUNT NO. 93552365 quoting name.
- Debit/Credit Card payment by telephone 01733 380489 (option 1)
- Send stamped addressed envelope if start time is required otherwise details will appear on the website after the closing date of the event.
- Standard Dress Code to apply
- Buggies – The use of buggies or ride-on vehicles is only permissible upon the production of a medical certificate. Buggies need to be booked via the Pro Shop and are subject to availability.
- No refunds will be made for entries cancelled after the closing date.
- If unable to play it is the responsibility of the entrant to arrange a replacement.
- If the event is abandoned during the competition due to inclement weather or course conditions if possible, the event will be re-arranged, and all entry fees carried forward. However, if any competitor has taken catering prior to abandonment, this fee will be deducted from the carried forward entry fee. In the event that competitors are unable to meet any re-arranged fixture a refund will be issued for the relevant refund amount less the cost of any meals taken
- If the event is cancelled due to adverse weather before play commences, a full refund will be given.
- In the event of inclement weather or course conditions, PMGC reserve the right to vary the Competition condition to achieve a result within the time available. e.g. reduction of holes played.
- Report to competition 'check in' at least 20 minutes before tee time (30 minutes if a two tee or shotgun start).
- Tee selection – at the discretion of the committee.
- The approximate presentation time 'if applicable' will appear on the start sheet. It would be preferable if a presentation of prizes is held that at least one person (if a pairs event) and two persons (if a team event) be present for the presentation of prizes.
- In the event of Gross and Nett prizes being awarded the Handicap prizes take preference and no competitor can win two prizes (other than spot prizes).
- Where home and visitor prizes are awarded, it is at the committees' discretion, after closing date, to assess the number of prizes in each category to be awarded. Does not apply to home & visitor mixed combinations.
- Where age group prizes are awarded, it is at the committees' discretion, after closing date, to assess the number of prizes in each category to be awarded.
- Where possible requested tee times will be met. In the event the time is already booked the nearest vacant time will be allocated. Tee times may be adjusted by the committee to take into account 'gaps' in start sheet after closing date.
- Distance measuring devices may be used to gauge distance only.
- Mobile telephones may only be used in the car park and clubhouse entrance lobbies. At all other times must be switched off or on silent in any other areas of the club including golf course other than for emergencies. Text messaging is also not permitted on the golf course.
- ETIQUETTE – the etiquette of golf must be observed at all times
