

## County Newsletter JANUARY 2020

A Happy New Year to all our club members across the County. The extremely wet weather, for many of our courses, has meant a number of closures or restricted playing conditions and we're all hoping for a much drier spell over the coming months.

Looking back over 2019, the good news is that overall male membership numbers are largely the same as in 2018. However, junior membership numbers are still declining (by approximately 9% in 2019). 15 clubs have less than 10 juniors on their books and this is a worrying sign. Hagley GC lead the way with over 43 junior boys.

1. The County Boys & Girls Combined Achievement Awards for 2019 – Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January at Kings Norton GC

Presentations of the 2019 trophies were given out by the respective County Presidents, **Mr David McGillivray and Mrs Judy Taylor.** An award voted for on the day by all the players themselves was given to **James Ilsley** (Stourbridge GC), to recognise his progress as one of the best team players and individual performers in 2019. Outstanding achievement awards were also given to **Hugh Adams** (Hagley GC) and **Hayden Sarfo** (Worcester G&CC) for their incredible golf in 2019. The conclusion of a very enjoyable afternoon was the announcement of the Boys' Team Captains for 2020. They are: **Harrison Leaver** U18s, (Gaudet Luce GC), **James Ilsley** U16s, (Stourbridge GC) and **Mark Hewlett** U14s, (Gaudet Luce GC).

## 2. The County Dinner – Friday 17th January at Kings Norton GC
