October Green Keeping report

Greens have improved significantly since application of high N fertiliser no sign of antrachnose at the current time but will be monitored over next few weeks.

With the positive feedback we are receiving about how good the greens are playing I have decided not to vertidrain till spring, so we are slitting them 2-3 times a week.

Course

Slitting of fairways is being carried out every week this will continue until ground conditions become too wet.

Flail mower was on site two weeks ago as you may have seen all areas of course have now been cut down, awaiting side arm flail to come on site to cut ditches and around lake, digger has been put back till spring as at the time it was due in there had been a lot of rain.

Great Coates road hedge will be cut Monday 18th October.

Heights of cut were lifted last week on fairways,

Tees, surrounds and approaches, due to fairway height coming up semi rough will now go back to rough height due to lack of definition between semi rough and fairways.
