	Ever up early with the dawn chorus. Refuses to leave stall if raining.	
4	<b>Great Overton</b>	<b>Chris Devonshire</b>
	Often understudy to Expectations. Aske yard colt. Good Test today.	
5	<b>World's Favorite</b>	<b>Andy Madeley</b>
	BA sponsored. Good forelegs. Can struggle over high fences.	
6	<b>Byron Basher</b>	<b>Paul Culley</b>
	Can veer drastically to right ... or left as the mood takes.

	Californian import out of Red Hot stable. Can't stop once going.

	Trouble starting with last owner. Now improving with more mileage.

	Easthamptead jumper with low centre of gravity. Likes his oats.	
5	<b>Fiver</b>	<b>Dot Hawker</b>
	Out of Watership stables on The Downs. Small but intelligent.	
6	<b>No</b>	<b>Helen Lake</b>
	Neighsayers have increased her odds despite her form this winter.	
7	<b>Lancashire Lad</b>	<b>Ann Lawson</b>
	No 1 in stables in the past. Living on past glories. Good handicap bet	
8	<b>Oh Gosh!</b>	<b>Ann Maisey</b>
	Sister to Dear Me. Shock winner last out. Surprisingly fast over flat.

	Short stride pattern. Nearing end of career. Unlikely to make stud.	
4	<b>Olliver's Army</b>	<b>Peter Smalley</b>
	Regularly found in the top 10. Could be No.1 this time out.	
5	<b>Cunning Linguist</b>	<b>Sandy Byfield</b>
	Stablemate to Cunning Stunts. Susceptible to the odd slip up.	
6	<b>Ad Astra</b>	<b>David Dudman</b>
	Can fly out of the stalls. Tends to hover in midfield during race.	
7	<b>Dobbin</b>	<b>Eleanor Maguire</b>
	A real workhorse. Happily plod along in midfield. Good each way bet.	
8	<b>The Mexican</b>	<b>Andy Meridith</b>
	Nearly always ahead of the handicapper. Worth a flutter.

	Frisky grey. Should make a lot of noise. Limped home last out.	
6	<b>Chip Away Vinnie</b>	<b>Vince Hanniffy</b>
	No hope! Tends to dig hooves in or fly across the surface.	
7	<b>Rascally Rabbit II</b>	<b>Toni Prince</b>
	Blinkered. Needs the whip. Missed last outing as tied up in red tape.

	Past winner. 3rd last out. Struggling with form at present.

	Elegant gliding stride. Won by a neck last year. Dislikes water.	
6	<b>Overdraft</b>	<b>Aimee Storer</b>
	Expensive purchase. Requires the best oats and spring water.	
7	<b>Norfolk N Chance II</b>	<b>John Bishop</b>
	Tends to veer right. At home among large plants. Long odds.	
8	<b>TC Trotter</b>	<b>TC</b>
	Brother to Top Hat. This horse doesn't fool around. Likes to lead race
