Overview

- Some key numbers
 - Competitions scorecards
 - Approximately 12,500 returned and checked
 - Strokeplay participation (averages)
 - Medals 225 players; Weekend 18-hole 175 players
 - ▶ Midweek 18-hole 65 players; Midweek 9-hole 20 players
 - Matchplay participation
 - Singles 164 players entered; 8 rounds in total
 - Foursomes 64 pairings; 6 rounds in total
 - Fourball 90 pairings; 7 rounds in total.



Overview

Timesheets

- ► The vast majority of weekends, the timesheet had adequate lines / slots to cope with demand
- On a few occasions, we had to add some extra lines or slots, with a view to maximising opportunity to play while minimising disruption.

Prize structures

- Introduction of additional divisions, ie, Division 5 and Seniors (age 60 & above) for 18-hole weekend competitions, to reduce budget surplus from Covid-19 period
- ► Autumn League more prizes at an overall level in conjunction with stableford points penalties for prize-winners; to maximise distribution of prizes among more members.

Communications

- Endeavoured to close competitions and post results to HowDidIdo asap after competitions end
- Newsletter issued twice weekly with weekend and midweek results and competitions updates
- Matchplay participants received email notifications for each round of matches.

Look Ahead to 2023

- Areas for consideration / Potential initiatives
 - Terms of Competition updated terms to protect the integrity of our competitions (will be issued prior to start of qualifying golf)
 - Ongoing review of prize structure
 - Scorecard return for all rounds of singles and fourball matchplays
 - Random draws within 30-minute brackets for medals and major competitions
 - Electronic scoring use of the HowDidiDo app for sole return of player scores and verification by marker
- Key considerations
 - Respect for the timesheet
 - No double bookings over Saturday/Sunday competition times
 - No booking of ladies lines (Saturdays 11.20, 11.30 and 11.40) prior to 8.00 on the Tuesday morning
 - Avoid no shows / late cancellations
 - Completion & return of scorecard (with both signatures), and input of score into screen or app

Handicaps Report 2022

- Handicap Committee Gerry Murray (Handicap Secretary), Joe Foley, Joe Lavin.
- ► The Handicap Committee met five times during 2022
- Two meetings were used to resolve individual handicap issues, and three meetings were held to prepare for, and undertake, the Annual Handicap Review.
- For the Annual Handicap Review, the Golf Ireland Clubhouse system provides six reports; Handicap Review, Handicap Change, Last Played to Handicap, Competition v General Play, Soft Cap/Hard Cap, nine-hole/eighteen hole comparisons
- ► The handicap committee meets to establish review criteria before it considers any of the six reports. The committee looked at all handicaps, not just those highlighted in reports
- Review was completed by the end of November 2022. Members impacted by the review were informed and the handicap changes were implemented

Handicaps Report 2022

- ► Elite golfer return Carton has 23 members classified as 'elite' golfers i.e. handicap index of 0.0 to plus. No other Irish club comes close to that number
- Competition v General Play report. Committee has concerns about variations in scoring patterns between competition and general play in a small number of cases
- A request for an adjustment to a handicap following illness/injury can only be based on scores made after the illness/injury (WHS Rule 7.1a/2)
- Golf Ireland is imposing handicap penalties directly on members' records where its App has been used incorrectly
- Committee will be working with the competitions committee to see if Club V1/HowDidiDo remain the best option for meeting the needs of the club. Other clubs doing the same.

Season Snapshots Part 1

- Brian Cunningham's Senior Cup team had victories over Stackstown, Woodbrook, Dun Laoghaire, Arklow, Grange, Naas, Tandragee and Cushendall on the way to All Ireland success.
- The **Barton Shield** team reached the Leinster South semi-final with wins over the K-Club. Lisheen Springs and Hermitage before narrowly missing out on a final appearance with a last hole defeat by Elm Park.
- The Duggan Cup team had great away wins against Knightsbrook and Ardree before falling to the tournament hosts, Edenderry, who needed to be at their best to end Carton's winning run.
- James O'Loughlin's Fred Perry team and the Metropolitan Cup team had wins against Slade Valley and Grange Castle respectively before falling to Wicklow and the K-Club in subsequent rounds.
- Ivan Genocky's Junior Cup team were beaten by a strong Dun Laoghaire team. A similar fate was experienced by Tom Healy's All Ireland Fourball and Straffan Cup teams at the K-Club and Millicent.





Season Snapshots Part 2

- Anthony Coscoran's Pierce Purcell team came very close to upsetting Edmonstown Golf Club, who needed extra holes in three games to sneak a 3-2 win before going on to win the Leinster South pennant.
- Adrian Murphy's **Mixed Foursomes** team also fell to Edmonstown in difficult conditions and can be proud of a performance that brought their match the full distance.
- Paul Duff's Jimmy Bruen team beat Naas in a challenge match before facing Lucan Golf Club in the first round proper but despite playing well, they couldn't overcome our near neighbours.
- The **Barton Cup** team managed to beat Lucan home and away in challenge matches but lost out on the final hole of the final game in their first round match away to Craddockstown.
- The North Leinster Senior Alliance is managed by Mick Wright, John Slevin and Tony McDonagh. This is an eight-round winter league with matches already played against Kilcock, Royal Tara, Lucan and Blackbush, with others against Westmanstown, Ardee, Headforrd and County Meath scheduled for the new year.
