

Code of Conduct

Practice Facility

Members

Practice balls will be available from the ball dispenser situated below the balcony staircase adjacent to the Professionals' shop. Tokens can be obtained from the Pro shop Members are entitled to three tokens per day free of charge. Additional tokens can be purchased from the Pro shop for a nominal charge of £2.00. In the event that the Pro shop is closed, tokens may be obtained from the bar, subject to availability. Should the dispenser become empty, the facility will be suspended until such time as balls have been collected and the dispenser restocked.

In connection with this facility Members should note the following:

- 1. Practice balls and baskets **must not be taken off site** under any circumstances.
- 2. Practice balls and baskets **must not be kept in Members' personal lockers** or elsewhere.
- 3. Practice balls are non-conforming under Rule 4.2a and cannot be used on the Golf Course
- 4. The Head Green Keeper will establish designated hitting areas each day which will be repositioned as necessary, and balls must not be played from outside these areas. Specifically, balls on the practice area **must not** be struck back toward the designated hitting areas.
- 5. Balls must not be collected after practice is completed, they will be collected each morning or as necessary.
- 6. Balls played to the practice chipping green should be cleared on completion and the area left clear for subsequent users.
- 7. Balls **must not** be struck when the practice ground is being mown.
- 8. Members using their own balls must take extreme care when collecting their balls on the practice area.

Guests, and Visitors

Practice balls are available from the ball dispenser situated below the balcony staircase adjacent to the Professionals' shop. Tokens can be obtained from the Pro shop for a charge of ± 3.00 .

In connection with this facility Guests and Visitors should note the following:

- 1. Practice balls and baskets must not be taken off site under any circumstances.
- 2. Practice balls are non-conforming under Rule 4.2a and cannot be used on the Golf Course
- 3. Balls must only be struck from the designated hitting areas and specifically, balls on the practice area **must not** be struck back toward the designated hitting areas.
- 4. Balls must not be collected after practice is completed.
- 5. Balls played to the practice chipping green should be cleared on completion and the area left clear for subsequent users.
- 6. Balls **must not** be struck when the practice ground is being mown.
