Winter work on course will now commence to include:

Bunker re shape on 4th, Bunker re instated on corner of 6th, 1st tee moved left and raised, Grass hollow to right of 1st green flattened and re shaped, Gorse and bushes to right of 1st fairway taken out and woodchipped.

Bushes between 3 and 2 removed, Tree canopies raised, extra tee built on 13th.

It may also be considered to verti drain and sand greens throughout the winter months so less work has to be carried out in the summer playing season.

Aprons and tees grass cut will be raised from 9mm to 11mm during winter, with the fairways being raised from 17mm to 20mm. The first cut of rough will come down from 3" to 2".

The DP World Tour stage 1 Qualifying week was a great success, despite some challenging weather conditions, and they have requested to return again next year.
We have also been approached by the Clutch Pro Tour for a possible event next year.
