Sign Up/ Booking	Please sign up for entry to the competition to be included in the draw. Sign up using the HowDidIDo app (you will need to register) or contact the captain. If you are not signed up but would like to play in the competition please ensure you are at the club half an hour before the first tee time or contact the Captain. Please be aware if you have not signed up in advance there may not be space available for you to play in the competition
Competition Draw	Competition draw details will be notified by the Club V1 system straight to your e-mail, displayed on the website and on noticeboards Note – There is no draw made for Men’s midweek competitions
Absence	If you have entered and cannot play please contact the Captain/ Vice Captain to let them know as soon as you can

Score Entry	You are expected to enter your score into the PSI terminal or HDID app at the end of your round unless the system is not working (in which case please report it to the pro shop)
Return of scorecard	Your score must be entered into the PSI terminal (for qualifying competitions) and scorecard returned as soon as possible when you come off the course and no later than 30 minutes after
