10	<b>Senior Captain's Report-</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Winter Eclectic has attracted 43 entrants who have enthusiastically taken on the challenge! Following a request from Simon Vines on the Competitions and Handicap Committee, we have requested that scores are submitted using the MyEG App whenever possible to reduce the number of Score Cards submitted.</li> <li>2. Hopefully, the Winter Eclectic will get Seniors more comfortable with submitting qualifying rounds every time that they play a round of golf. The new WHS is I think designed for this approach to handicap assessment.</li> <li>3. It is also going to make handicaps more representative of current playing ability when we start our full calendar of matches with other clubs starting early April.</li> <li>4. Around 30 seniors have agreed to co-sponsor Max Nicholls by paying £100 p.a. for two years. Some have elected to pay £200 p.a. We have started collecting these contributions into the new Seniors bank account with Barclays, which is now up and running. Max has just issued his first Newsletter, which I have forwarded to the 30 seniors co-sponsors.</li> <li>5.
