Directions to Brampton Park Golf Club

If you're driving along the new A1 or the new A14 you may notice that Brampton Park Golf Club seemingly no longer exists. There are no signposts on either new road and if you're using a SatNav it may indicate that you're in the middle of a field, unless of course you've updated it! Below are some very simple directions to Brampton Park Golf Club that may help you – they are correct as of Feb 2020. Please be aware that since the roadworks the Police are very active and often deploy a mobile speed camera van in the 30 mph zone on the Huntingdon side of the golf club.

If you are coming either west from St Ives or south from Chatteris — There are no changes to the routes you've probably used many times either via the Huntingdon outer ring road and "Spittals interchange" or the inner ring road then the B1514, Huntingdon Road, past the railway station (note that this road may be closed at night during works to dismantle the old A14 flyover).

If you are coming west from Cambridge on the new A14 – Proceed along the new A14 and IGNORE signs for Huntingdon/St Ives (which will take you up to the old A14 which is CLOSED at Godmanchester), continue on the new A14 until Junction 22, this is just after the bridge over the river Great Ouse and is signposted as the A1 (Peterborough) and also Huntingdon Racecourse (brown sign), you will now be on a flyover to join the A1 northbound. Join the A1, stay in the left hand lane and after 1m take the first exit, signposted Midlands/Kettering/M1 M6 (also Huntingdon Racecourse brown sign). On the exit you will reach Brampton Hut roundabout, take the 4th exit, signposted as Brampton/Huntingdon B1514 (this is the old A14 spur road). Follow the directions at *** below.

If you are coming south from Peterborough – Proceed down the A1 and at the old A14 exit at Alconbury keep right and continue on the A1, signposted on overhead gantry as London (C and W). You will now be on the new improved A1 section. Continue to follow the A1 for approx. 3½m, you then have two options:

Option 1 – Take the exit, signposted Midlands/Kettering/M1 M6 and Huntingdon Racecourse (brown sign) at the end of the slip road you will come to traffic lights on Brampton Hut roundabout. Take the first exit, signposted as Brampton/Huntingdon B1514 (this is the old A14 spur road). Follow the directions at *** below.

Option 2 – Ignore the sign for Midlands/Kettering/M1 M6 and continue on the A1, which will start to split, keep in the right hand lanes and follow the gantry signs for London C and W. After 2m you will enter a 50 mph zone and there is an exit, signposted Landfill Site and at the very last moment a Brampton sign. Take the exit and follow the road to a new roundabout, take the 2nd exit and go under the new A14. Brampton Park Golf Club is approx. 1¼m on the right.

If you are coming north up the A1 – This route is nearly unaffected by the construction of the new A1/A14. Continue up the A1 past St Neots until the Buckden Roundabout. Go straight over as usual continuing up the A1. After 1m take the first exit, signposted Brampton/Huntingdon B1514. Loop round and go under the A1 (controlled by traffic lights) and you will come to a new roundabout, go straight over and under the new A14. Brampton Park Golf Club is approx. 1½m on the right.

If you are coming east from Kettering on the new A14 – Exit the new A14 at Junction 21, signposted A1 North/Peterborough and Huntingdon A141. At the elevated roundabout go straight over (2nd exit) and follow signs for Huntingdon. Continue to Brampton Hut roundabout. Go straight over, sign posted as Brampton/Huntingdon B1514 (this is the old A14 spur road). Follow the directions at *** below.

*** At this point your SatNav should be working again. After ½m take the first exit, signposted as Brampton/Huntingdon B1514, at the roundabout at the top (this is Huntingdon Race course roundabout) take the 4th exit, signposted Brampton/Huntingdon B1514. You will go over the old A14 and then reach a roundabout, take the 2nd exit, again signposted Brampton/Huntingdon B1514. Keep straight on across a mini roundabout then a pelican crossing and you will see signs for Brampton Park Golf Club (brown sign). Please note that due to all the road changes/closures this ¾m section into Brampton gets very busy between 8 and 9 am. At the next roundabout take the second exit (effectively turning right), proceed past the church and a pub, The Black Bull, (on the left), and another pub, The Dragoon (on the right), then a pelican crossing and go straight on at the next roundabout. After approx. 600 yds turn left into Brampton Park Golf Club.
