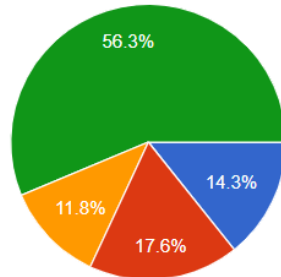


During the April to October months, we schedule 15 weekend stableford competitions, 11 weekend strokes competitions, 3 weekend fourball competitions and 4 team competitions.

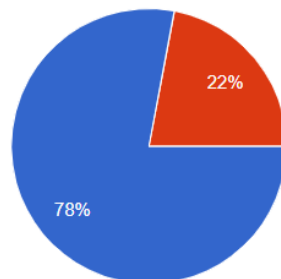


- Reduce the number of singles stableford competitions and increase the number of fourball competitions

Did you find it easy to book tee-times with the two competitions?

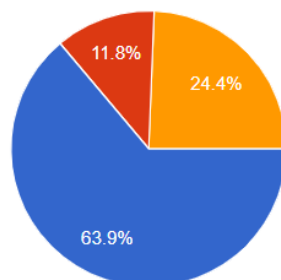

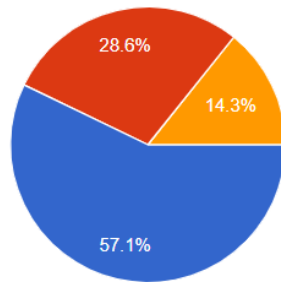


- Yes, I prefer qualifying golf where possible

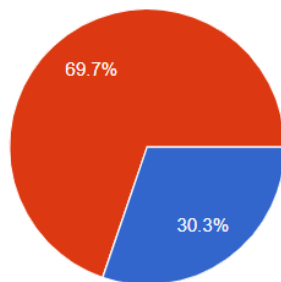


- Yes, I'd prefer one single non qualifying competition and more holes where possible

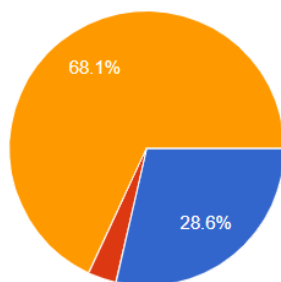

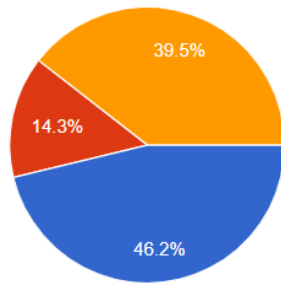


- No shows have decreased

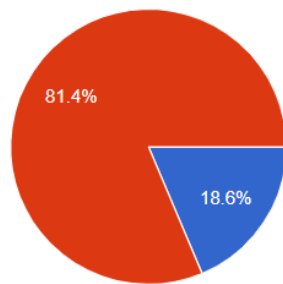


- Better - keep it at 8pm Monday
