

Dr Jim Morrison Player Of the Year Trophy

The Player of the Year ranking points will be allocated based on how a player performs against the Competition Standard Scratch (CSS). Points are awarded as follows for all POY competitions;

- 10 points for equalling the CSS
- Addition of 1 point for each stroke better than the CSS
- Reduction of 1 point for each stroke worse than the CSS
- No points are awarded for scores greater than the CSS + 9, i.e. no negative scores

* Points for qualifiers depends on their score relative to CSS and thereafter the winner of each round receives an additional point.

** For Vice Captains prize, 7pts for equalling the CSS and additional points to top 5 overall (1st- 5pts to 5th-1pt)

Each competitor's best 8 scores from the 10 qualifying events will count towards their Player of the Year ranking. In the event of a tie in the final standings the "Golfer of the Year" will be determined via a countback as follows;

- Last 3 counting scores*
- Then the last 2 counting scores*
- Then the last counting score*

Note: Donoghmore Cup points awarded to all qualifiers at conclusion of competition and will then be counted as a score.
