

April course update

The last 2 weeks weather has certainly changed the ground conditions for gardeners and golf courses alike. So much so that watering has commenced on both courses following the completion of the coring and dressing programme. Over 100 tons of sand has been applied to the greens of both courses over the last 2 weeks. The greens are recovering remarkably fast with the warm conditions and no traffic. Next week all the greens will receive an application of 9:0:27 plus mag and trace element fertiliser along with the tee areas.



The 18th greenside bunkers has now been sculptured to minimise any possible issues arising from golf balls heading to the Lyle bar area! The smaller 2nd bunker has been taken out of play but the first left bunker has been brought in from the left side and the face of it has been revetted to give a striking effect. Looks a bit like the 17th Road hole at St Andrew's, the "sands of Nakajima" or in our case "sands of Tudor, who headed up the team who did all the construction work.
