# **Notes for Organisers of Visiting Societies**

The following notes are to help ensure that your visit to Walmer & Kingsdown Golf Club is enjoyable.

- 1. On arrival, introduce yourself to the Club Professional and Steward to confirm numbers and tee times.
- 2. Please ensure that your members are ready to play at the correct time to avoid over-running booked tee times.
- 3. Ensure your members are aware of the etiquette of golf and play at a reasonable pace. Please do not put all slower golfers together.
- 4. If not already ordered, bacon rolls, coffee and cooked breakfasts are available from 0800 hours. Please phone the Steward in advance to book.
- 5. Food ordered in advance **WILL** be charged for the numbers booked, unless 24hrs notice is given.
- 6. For larger bookings, a halfway hut may be available to serve drinks and bacon/sausage rolls. Again, please book in advance through the Secretary.

## **Dress Rules**

On the course acceptable golfing attire must be worn at all times, if in doubt please ask in the Pro Shop. Specifically, jeans, trainers, football shirts, t shirts & cargo shorts are not permitted. In the clubhouse smart casual dress is the minimum requirement. Trainers and soiled golfing attire are not permitted. A jacket and tie is required in the restaurant after 1900 hours. The clubhouse is a non-smoking area.
