Course Update:

Steve and the Team have been very hard at work during the current lockdown.

- An Open Ditch has been put in on the 7th hole.
- Trenching has been put in on the 7th, 8th, 10th for new drains to be laid to improve drainage.
- Current open ditches have been cleared of leaves and debris and will continue to be cleaned throughout the year.

Fortunately, there appears to have been no serious snow damage to the greens.



The ditch is just about finished on the 7th and the good news is it does have water in it when it rains.
