The Ladies' section has suspended their normal competition fixtures due to the COVID-19 outbreak but the following non-qualifying competitions will run from the week beginning 6th July to the end of September:

Ladies' 18 hole Matchplay Ladder

- Players will be initially positioned on the ladder in reverse order of handicap
- The ladder will be emailed to all participants
- Any player can challenge an opponent within 2 places of themselves on the ladder
- If the lower placed player wins, then the 2 players switch places on the ladder
- Matchplay format using full difference between the current handicaps
- Submit match result to ladies@stonehavengolfclub.com

Covid League 18 hole - Stableford; play at any time on Tuesdays

Covid League 9 hole – Stableford; play at any time on Tuesdays

Covid Eclectic 18 hole – Strokeplay; play at any time on Thursdays; Silver and Bronze

Covid Eclectic 9 hole – Strokeplay; play at any time on Thursdays

You should mark your own card in these competitions but make sure that you verbally agree the score after each hole and at the end of the round. There is no need to hand in your card at the end of your round but it should be retained in case any issues arise.

The competitions will be set up on Club V1 and players should sign in and enter their own scores using HowDidiDo, if possible. If anyone is unable to use HowDidiDo then scores should be sent to <u>ladies@stonehavengolfclub.com</u>.

The League winners will be the players with the most points from their 8 best League rounds. The Eclectic winners will be the players with the lowest aggregate score over all rounds played. After each round, the score at a hole where a lower gross score is achieved will be updated. You can keep a record of your own progress or you can let the computer do the calculations at the end of September.

Supplementary Scores

Anyone wishing to play for handicapping purposes, while no qualifying competitions are being held by the ladies' section, can submit a supplementary score. Any number of supplementary scores may be submitted.

- A player intending to return a supplementary score must email ladies@stonehavengolfclub.com before her round
- A supplementary score must be returned under Stroke Play conditions and can be played over the 9-hole (front 9) or 18-hole course
- The scorecard must be marked by a responsible person acceptable to the committee
- Both player's and marker's cards should be returned to the pavilion
- If a scorecard is not returned, the player's handicap will be increased by 0.1
