

Seniors 4 Day Open

Tuesday 20th to Friday 23rd May 2025

Conditions:

- The competition shall be Stableford over 18 holes. Played on both the Old & New Courses from the BLUE TEES (Men) and GREEN TEES (Women).
- The main competition is played over three rounds with two rounds on the Old Course and one round on the New Course.
- Final day is a Three Person Better Ball Stableford on the New Course.
- Open to all amateur golfers as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and who are Members of a recognised Golf Club.
- Women's minimum age is 50 and men must be 55 or over on the first day of play.
- Each entrant must be in possession of a WHS handicap index. Maximum Handicap Index is Men 24; Women 36. Those entrants who have a Handicap Index above 24 (Men) or 36 (Women) will have their index reduced accordingly.
- The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and in accordance with the local rules of Moray Golf Club.
- Entry fee ~ £40.00 Members; £120.00 Visitors. Entry Fee must be paid on submission of Entry. Full refunds may not be given if withdrawing after 18th May.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning any reason therefore and to alter or add to these conditions. Its decision will be final.
- Tee times will be allocated on receipt of Entry via the BRS Booking System.
- In the event of a tie, the Competition shall be decided on the best score for the last 9, 6, 3, 2 or one hole(s). No competitor shall receive more than one prize.
- It is requested that Members and Visitors observe the Moray Golf Club's dress code.

Prizes:

- There will be prizes for each of four days while also having an aggregate prize for the three Stableford rounds.
- There will be two age section for men split evenly
- Within these sections there will be two Divisions which will based on entrants and handicaps.
- There will be one Division for ladies.
