Men's 90th Amateur Open Meeting

The 90th Men's Amateur Open meeting will be staged on Thursday 4th August, Friday 5th August and Saturday 6th August 2022. known as "the Dupree", this prestigious event is one of the premier open meetings in the South of England and features four separate competitions contested over 3 days, with some excellent prizes on offer.

The Dupree Challenge Cup

The main event is the Dupree Challenge Cup. This magnificent trophy was presented to the club by Sir William Dupree in 1925. A field of 160 players competes in the qualifying round on Thursday and the top 8 players progress to the knock-out match-play stages.

The quarter-finals are contested over 18 holes on Friday morning, with the winners playing the semi-finals on Friday afternoon. The final is held over 36 holes on Saturday and the worthy winner is entitled to hold the trophy for one year.



Four Ball Better Medal

A field of 96 pairs competes in the 4 Ball Better Ball medal competition on Friday, with valuable prizes for the top teams.

Foursomes Medal

On Saturday morning 40 pairs play in the Foursomes medal competition with prizes for gross and net scores.

Individual Stableford

The final event on Saturday is an Individual Stableford with a field of 96 competitors.

The meeting concludes with prize-giving and an optional supper.

The Handicap Index is limited to 18 for all competitions. However, players with higher Handicap Indexes may enter the 4BBB, Foursomes and Stableford competitions and calculate their Course Handicap off 18.
