

Dress Code



On the Course including practice areas and putting greens...

- All golfers must wear clothing designed for the purpose of playing golf which is available from a golf professional retail outlet.
- Men's shirts must be tucked in to their trousers.
- Hats and visors must not to be worn backwards.
- Footwear must be designed for playing golf, with soft spikes or pimpled/moulded soles; other types of footwear are not permitted.
- Socks should always be worn. When worn with shorts these should be either white ankle length or white trainer socks.

Off the Course, in the Clubhouse, on the patio or in the car park...

Acceptable:

- Clean golf attire.
- Clean and smart casual dress.
- Men's footwear worn with socks, Deck-shoes without socks.

Not acceptable:

- Wet or dirty clothing must not be worn or brought into the Clubhouse beyond the entrance and locker rooms.
- Shorts above $\frac{3}{4}$ mid-thigh.
- Beach-wear, flip flops or other sports-wear including bare feet.
- Ripped jeans.
- Golf shoes, other than on the terrace, in the Locker Room and Pro Shop areas and except in dry weather conditions (members will be advised when this is the case).
- Hats inside the Clubhouse.

NGC staff and officers of the Club may deem any clothing or footwear unacceptable for both on and off the course according to their judgement.
