BYE-LAWS (September 2022)

- 1. The rules for management of the Club are as contained in the Articles of Association together with the under mentioned Byelaws.
- 2. The Clubhouse will normally be open between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00. Any variations to these hours, as determined by the Board, will be advised, and displayed on the Club Notice Board.
- 3. Noise Members and Guests are respectfully requested to leave the Clubhouse having regard to the needs of local residents and to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors, sounding horns, loud use of vehicle stereos and anti-social behaviour. The activity of persons leaving the Clubhouse will be monitored.
- 4. The Clubhouse and course will be closed on Christmas Day and on any other occasions that the Board may decide.
- 5. Persons under the age of 18 will not be supplied with and/or sold alcohol.
- 6. Country Member Cannot play in major club competitions. Previously having been a Full, Restricted, or 5-day member, and permanent residence must be 100 miles or more from the club.
- 7. Regulations for play on the course, which are to be determined by the Board, will be displayed on the Club Notice Board.
- 8. The Club and male members are governed by membership of the Yorkshire Union of Golf Clubs and by the English Golf Union, which is the governing body for the administration of English golf. The Club and male members are therefore subject to the rules of the English Golf Union. Female members are governed by the constitution of the English Women's Golf Association and Yorkshire Ladies County Golf Association.
- 9. Catering Meals and light refreshments will be served in the Clubhouse at times and circumstance agreed by the Board with the Caterer and displayed on the Club Notice Board.
- 10. The Club is in no way responsible for the engagement or payment of caddies. Caddies will be engaged and paid for by the individuals concerned and will also be responsible for the caddy observing Club rules.
- 11. The subscription year will commence on 1 January.
- 12. Excluding invitation days or being part of a visiting society a member's guest may be signed in on no more than 12 occasions irrespective of the member making the introduction. The members guest fee will apply. At weekends members guest are only allowed after 4pm on Saturdays and after 12.30 pm on Sundays.
- 13. Members of the Club in the Social category of membership will be treated as member's guests for the purpose of limiting the number of times golf can be played. The members guest fee must be paid.
- 14. Intermediate categories of membership will be 18-21yrs, 22-25yrs & 26-29yrs.
