



# GENERAL or CASUAL PLAY SCORECARDS

(formerly known as Supplementary Cards)

A general play card may be submitted for any of the following purposes:

- 1) To enable a handicap index to be allocated for the first time
- 2) To maintain an up to date handicap index
- 3) To enable the Handicap Committee to carry out reviews and adjustments depending on the scores achieved and within the rules of handicapping

## Procedure

- Players MUST sign in to the PSI screen, in either the foyer or Pro Shop, BEFORE commencing their General Play round
  - Please ensure the correct tees are selected. i.e. White, Yellow or Red
- On completion of the round players MUST record the score on either of the PSI screens. This should be done the same day as the round is played.
- The completed scorecard MUST be placed in the competitions box in the foyer just outside the men's changing rooms. Please ensure the card is completed correctly with the player's name and signature, marker's name, tee used, date and scores.
- The round MUST be played in adherence to the Rules of Golf. E.g. 'Gimmes' are not allowed
- Cards must be marked or verified by a person holding an official World Handicapping System Handicap Index
- To enable an initial handicap index allocation a total of 54 holes must be played over either the designated 9 hole or 18 hole course (or any combination of both) and always starting from the first tee.
