Match Play Under Handicap

2023 – 2024

Conditions

1. Open to any combination of ladies and gentlemen other than that professional golfers cannot be paired together. Ladies to play from red and gentlemen from white tees, current club handicap indexes will apply. Professionals to play off +2.0. Playing Handicap limits: Ladies 24 - Gentlemen 18. The allowance will be half of the full difference between the aggregate handicap of either side (half to count as one); using the men's stroke index.

NO MORE THAN 18 STROKES WILL BE RECEIVED IN ANY MATCH

2. Entries should be forwarded to Perranporth Golf Club **ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE OF £90 for visitors per pair, (flexible members entry £90.00 per pair as per flexible membership Terms & Conditions) and £40 for Perranporth members.** (This includes cost of entry into Finals Day support competition). **ENTRIES CLOSE SUNDAY 24 September 2023.**
3. One practice round only may be played without the payment of a green fee, at any agreed time, prior to the first round ONLY, provided the entrance fee has been paid.
4. The draw will take place after entry has closed, at the very latest by 30 September 2023. This will be placed on our web site www.perranporthgolfclub.co.uk and copies of the draw will be forwarded to the entrants by email. **ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ALTERED AFTER FIRST ROUND HAS BEEN PLAYED.**
5. **ANY PAIR NOT ABLE TO PLAY AT DATE OR TIME SPECIFIED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
6. First round 08 October 2023. Subsequent rounds: 12 November 2023, 07 January 2024, 28 January 2024, 18 February 2024, and Finals Day 03 March 2024. The Finals are over 36 holes. All other rounds are 18 holes, to be played to a finish.
7. The use of buggies in this competition is not allowed, unless the player is in possession of a medical exemption certificate.
8. There will be a plate competition for those knocked out in the 1st round. Same rules apply as the main competition.
9. Total prize money of vouchers exceeds £2500.
10. Prizes for winner's main competition £1000 per pair, £400 per pair runners up, £100 per pair losing semi-finalists and £50 per pair quarter-finalists (vouchers).
11. Prizes for plate competition winners £200 per pair, £100 per pair runners up, £50 per pair losing semi-finalists and £30 per pair quarter-finalists (vouchers).
12. Further prize fund of £250 will be awarded to the winning or last professional in the competition. If there is more than one individual, the prize fund will be split appropriately.
13. **MEN'S SCORE CARD TO BE USED FOR ALL MATCHES.**
14. Fairway mats may be introduced if necessary.
15. The competition committee reserves the right to add, alter or amend any of these conditions and its decision shall be final.
16. The first 62 entries who have paid will gain automatic entry into the draw. Should the event be over-subscribed, a waiting list will come into operation should any pairs withdraw before the start of the competition.
