The germination was poor this spring but May and June were good, not so good for golfing but the rain did help and we now have more than satisfactory fairways. 50 times better now in our opinion, still a few areas not great and in need of improvement but overall I am happy with them. I was not saying that at the start of May, however with wetting agent being applied every 3/4 weeks, watering with the browser at least once each week , liquid fertiliser (small amount) every 3/4 weeks, fairways are getting better every day . Hopefully this is everyone's perception as well.

New, and old, Bunkers are slowly settling in, with the sand more structured. We will kept watering them over the coming summer so they retain structure.
