Prior to hitting approach shots over the ditch/mound, ensure the players are clear of the 9th green. 5. Bridges left and right of the Water Hazard, ensure you cross in single file staying in the centre of the bridges 6. Be aware of players on the 10th tee when hitting approach shots to the green. 25. 15th Playing Tee to Green	Players/Staff/Occupants & Contractors on Hardy Farm Development.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Early morning daily checks of the adjacent site perimeter on the left by Green Keepers. 2. Net erected on 15th tee 2m high directing golfer to play shots to the right 150yd marker. 3. Sign on the 15th Tee warning golfers to aim away from the fence/line of conifers and to report any stray shots (time, date & by whom) into the development to the Pro Shop. 4. Line of conifers angled right directing golfers a further 10 yds to the right of the fairway. 5. Existing fairway has been moved a further 10yds from the perimeter fence angled towards the left. 6. Designated conservation area with young deciduous trees (marked blue) separates perimeter fence on the left of the fairway from the fairway, no play from inside that area, players must take relief. 7. Centre of fairway at 150 yds has been moved a further 11 yds right to create dog leg. 8. 90cm aiming disc/board installed on tree @ 200-220 yd creating and indicating a dog leg landing area. 9. Existing green has been extended/shaped a further 5yds right. 10. Area to the right of the green had the mound removed and 16 mature/dead trees removed (sycamore) which opened up a further 16yds to the right of the green landing/playing area to support the new dog leg. 11. Teeing off should only commence after the approaching players/staff from the 8th Green have been signalled to stop or have been waved through by players on the 15th tee 12. Be aware of Footballers behind green, Green Keepers to ensure that the existing height (15ft/5m) of perimeter hedges/shrubbery at the existing fence is maintained. 13. Steep slope to the right of fairway and 15th green, players to exercise caution. 	Low	A

Lateral Water Hazard on the left at bottom of hill after the ladies tee marked with Red Posts, Do Not Enter 5. Lateral Water Hazard on left of fairway marked with Red Posts, Do Not Enter 6. Lateral Water Hazard between 150-100yd markers on left and right of fairway marked with Yellow Posts, Do Not Enter 7. Water Hazard on the left at bottom of hill approaching green marked with Yellow Posts, Do Not Enter 8. Be aware of golfers on the 8th tee when climbing the hill to the 16th green, stop if necessary unless waved on. 	Low	A
