

# The Harvest 4BBB Competition

## TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The Harvest Competition is open to all members of the YLCGA.
2. This competitions is a 4BBB Stableford, with best score to count on all holes. Played from 85% Course Handicap Index
3. Competitors must enter as a team, the combined HI must not exceed 72.0 with individual HI's between 20.0 and 40.0
  - a) Players who have reduced below the Competition HI after entering will be eligible and must play from their new HI.
  - b) Players who increase above the maximum limit after entering must play from the Competition Handicap Index limit.
4. **Competitors will be responsible for maintaining a correct HI on the England Golf WHS platform; which will be used for verification of HI.**
5. It is the responsibility of the couple to provide a marker in the event of one or other of them being unable to play.
6. Entries for this meeting will be accepted from November each year.
7. Entries will be accepted from an individual member of the YLCGA via Golf Genius using the YLCGA website under Competitions.
8. Payment is made using Golf Genius
9. Closing date is 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2023
10. No receipts will be sent, entry fees to be returned should an event be over-subscribed or cancelled.
11. If any competition is oversubscribed a ballot for tee times will take place after the advertised closing date.
12. A list of starting times will be posted on the YLCGA website.
- 13 Prizes will be given in 2 equal numbered divisions as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams (depending upon entries).
  - Ties will be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s).
13. Reject balls and non-conforming drivers are not allowed. Penalty DISQUALIFICATION.
14. Motorised buggies may be used in accordance with the YLCGA Transportation Policy and at the discretion of the host club. Competitors must have obtained permission from the County Secretary before they can use a buggy. Permission must be renewed annually. The buggy may only be used by the person named on the medical certificate and may only carry the player, her caddie and equipment. See Transportation Policy.
15. Competitors should notify the competition organisers of any medication or allergies which may be relevant in the event of any accident or emergency. Forms will be available at the registration desk.
16. The decision of the County Competition Organiser (**or her designated representative**) is final.
