BE ALERT- PLAY SAFE - STAY SAFE

Update 2 following Government Announcement of May 28th 2020

- 1. From June 6th 2020 (not before) members and guests will be able to play in three balls at Lightcliffe GC.
 - Up until that time we already have BRS bookings for two balls in place that will be honoured. BRS booking sheets will be changed to reflect this on Saturday, May 30th for bookings commencing June 6th 2020.
- 2. PLEASE NOTE THAT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE 4 BALL GOLF WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT LIGHTCLIFFE GOLF CLUB.
- 3. The 10 minute interval between tee times will remain.
- 4. As before play will start at 8am to allow the greens staff to carry out work as safely as possible.
- 5. The practice ground (including the practice chipping area) will now be open subject to the following restrictions:
 - a. Keep the gate closed at all times.
 - b. <u>Take your own hand sanitizer</u> and use it before touching the gate both entering and leaving the practice area.
 - c. Please clearly mark your own golf balls for identification purposes and pick them all up at the end of your practice session. If possible use a ball pick up tube.

- e. The two covered practice bays must not be used until further notice.
