

CLOSED MEETING

Originally started when the Open Meeting became oversubscribed and members were prevented from entering. It provides a great day's golf for members: Singles Medal in the morning and 10 holes of Greensomes in the afternoon.

THE TROPHIES (see individual pages for further details)

The Bunty Eke Trophy is awarded to the player with the Lowest Gross Score.

The Margaret Self Cup is awarded for the Lowest Nett score. The winner can either be the player who is first in the Silver Division **or** the player who is first in the Bronze Division, whoever has the lower score.

THE PRIZES

- No player shall win more than one prize (ie gift prize) for the morning round at the Closed Meeting with the exception of 'Nearest the Pin' and 'Longest/Straightest Drive'.
- Prizes (ie gift prizes) should be awarded **in this order**:
 - Lowest Gross Score
 - 2nd Lowest Gross Score
 - Best Nett Silver Division
 - Best Nett Bronze Division
- Prizes are also awarded for Nearest the Pin, Longest/Straightest Drive and for the Best Afternoon Pairs.
- It is important that the actual positions achieved by the players are published, regardless of the prizes that they have won.
- In the event of a tie for either of these trophies, the winner will be determined by countback on holes 10-18, regardless of whether the players started on the 1st or 11th tee.
- Players may win prizes for the afternoon competition in addition to the morning round.
- If the winner of the Bunty Eke Trophy also has the Lowest Nett Score, she may also win the Margaret Self Cup.

Notes:

- If a player drops out of the morning round at short notice and a substitute cannot be found, the remaining player must either join the last pair or drop out too in order that the speed of playing in pairs is maintained.
- Sandwiches are pre-booked for lunch and this competition is followed by a meal and prize-giving.
