We pride ourselves on providing a friendly service throughout the Clubhouse and Pro-shop and you will be sure to enjoy playing a course that is renowned for its excellent condition and outstanding presentation.

Please make yourself and your players aware of the following Terms and Conditions: -

- i. An indication of the number of players taking part should be notified to the office when the booking is confirmed. Exact numbers must be advised 3 days before the meeting. These are the numbers that will be invoiced (unless there has been a mutual agreement to increase the numbers). If your group falls below the advised number, then catering costs will need to be covered. Green fees may be adjusted accordingly.
- ii. Bookings will only be accepted on the return of the official booking forms accompanied by the requested deposit. Payment should be made to the Office or Bar Steward on the day, allowances will be made in respect of Green Fees for Members of Willingdon Golf Club who may be participating in the society's meeting.
- iii. Any cancellation must be made in writing two months before the organised date, the deposit may be accepted as a cancellation charge. If less than 2 months' notice is given, we will require 50% of the total package cost.
- iv. Play will be from the Yellow Tee markers and starting tee(s) will be booked for a fixed period, according to the size of Society and format of play. Starting times will not be earlier than 8.30am depending on the booking and may be subject to alteration if circumstances dictate.
- v. Breakfast is only available before 10am if booked as part of your package.
- vi. It is expected that members of all visiting Societies will be reasonably experienced golfers who are fully conversant with the etiquette and rules of golf. Local rules applying at the time of the meeting must be observed and we only allow wide wheel trolleys.
- vii. Slow play must be avoided and players losing distance to the extent that a hole ahead is clear must call the players following through. All divots and pitch marks are to be replaced and repaired and bunkers smoothed after use.
- viii. The Club cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to visitor's property.
- ix. No reductions can be made if inclement weather, including frost and frozen conditions, affects your golf day, in any way, unless the course is closed.
- x. On behalf of the Golf Society, I hereby accept the terms and conditions. I enclose our deposit to secure our booking; I also confirm that all members of the society will be briefed on dress code and etiquette.
