Rules and Expectations

General Play at EMGC

1. All wishing to input a general play score should check in at the pro shop prior to commencing the round. This could be done via phone call or on arrival at the club. For late/early games please phone ahead in case the pro shop is closed
2. If there is no score registered on the system after pre-registering with the pro or a score is entered without first pre registering action will be taken by the competitions committee in the form of a ban in relation to the SGU General Play scheme.
3. When playing for a general play round there are a number of tees that can be selected and it is therefore important for the integrity of the handicaps at EMGC that players play from the tees they select on the app.

Expectations

1. This is a new concept for the golf club whereby members can access various teeing areas depending on their preference. The competitions committee however will ask that only players wishing to play for a general play score should play from the medal tees.
2. PACE OF PLAY - There are concerns regarding the pace of play so it is asked players are mindful of their surroundings and are considerate to fellow members. If you are holding up the game behind it is expected that you will allow that match to play through to keep up the pace of play.
3. GENERAL EXPECTATION - We are all members of the golf club meaning it is our golf course. In this case let us all work together to make sure our golf course is in the best playing condition possible by sanding divots on tees, replacing divots on the fairway, fixing pitch marks, raking bunkers etc. These small tasks make a massive difference to the playing experience for us all.
