

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## **GUIDANCE NOTES FOR CORPORATE AND GOLF SOCIETY VISITORS**

## **Corporate and Society days**

Corporate and Golf Society visitors are welcomed at Dunstable Downs on weekdays, except Wednesday. On Fridays, the number of players in a Society is limited to 20. We may be able to accommodate a limited number of small societies at weekends, subject to normal Club activities.

## Tee of the day

Play will be from yellow tees for gentlemen and red tees for ladies.

## **Playing format**

Play should be in three balls unless playing Foursomes or Greensomes. Where possible, players should play a Stableford format and must pick up if unable to score. <u>Texas Scramble format is not permitted.</u>

## Playing ability and etiquette

All players are expected to be of "handicap ability" and be fully conversant with golfing etiquette and the Rules of Golf. Whilst players need not be members of a recognised golf club, a Corporate or Golf Society day is not the time to learn the game and we would stress that novices may not use the course. The Club reserves the right to ask any player to leave the course who appears to be lacking in ability or knowledge of the rules and etiquette.

### Pace of play

All groups are asked to keep up with the group in front and not just ahead of the group behind. Any group which loses a clear hole and is delaying the group behind should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group.

### Care of the golf course

Please repair pitch marks on greens, replace divots and smooth over footprints in bunkers.

### Golf buggies

We have a limited number of golf buggies for hire at £25 per round, £37.50 for 28 holes and £45 for the day. To check the availability of buggies, please telephone the Professional's shop on 01582 662806.

## **Catering**

Final numbers for catering should be advised to the Club Caterers at least 48 hours before your visit. The Caterers can be contacted on 01582 604472 (option 4).

### **Green fees**

Final numbers for golf should be advised at least 48 hours before play and details confirmed in the General Manager's office on the day of your visit, **<u>before teeing off</u>**.

### **Payment**

Unless agreed beforehand, payment for golf and catering must be made on the day.

## Golf shop

Our fully stocked Professional's shop carries many major brands and will be able to meet all your golfing requirements in terms of equipment, clothing and prizes. ### Dress code

A copy of the Club's dress code is enclosed for your information. All visitors are expected to maintain a standard of dress which will not embarrass others, either on the golf course or in the clubhouse.

### Mobile telephones

The use of mobile phones for voice conversation is not permitted on the golf course or within the confines of the clubhouse and should be switched to silent at all times. However, they are permitted at all times in the event of an emergency and may be used for voice conversation on the balcony and in the car parks .



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## **CORPORATE AND GOLF SOCIETY DRESS REGULATIONS**

Your co-operation in the upkeep of the Club's dress code is appreciated. Staff and officers of the club will uphold these rules so, to prevent any unnecessary embarrassment, please ensure you take time to read the outline below and support the Club in maintaining its high standards.

We ask that you are appropriately dressed at all times and thank you for your support.

## **Golf Course**

Clean smart golf attire is required for the golf course.

Denim clothing, jeans, printed or collar-less t-shirts, football style shirts, tracksuits, trainers and for gentlemen cut off trousers, combat style trousers and cargo shorts are not permitted on the golf course.

Gentlemen and ladies may wear tailored golf shorts to the specified maximum knee length in both the clubhouse and bar. Gentlemen must wear either plain knee length hose, trainer socks or predominantly white over the ankle sports socks.

Gentlemen must tuck shirts inside trousers / shorts waistband.

## **Clubhouse**

Smart casual dress may be worn in the lounge, bar and dining room at all times.

Smart casual dress includes smart, full length denim trousers but not printed or collar-less t-shirts, football style shirts, tracksuits, trainers and for gentlemen cut off trousers, combat style trousers and cargo shorts. Denim is allowed, but as with any other trousers, they should be 'in good taste' and not be torn, ripped, frayed, multicolour or dirty.

Wet or soiled clothes must not be worn in the upstairs area of the clubhouse.

Waterproof golf clothing must not be worn in the upstairs area of the clubhouse.

## Dining Room

Men - smart casual, i.e. tailored trousers, smart jeans, collared shirt.

Ladies - either a dress, or a shirt or blouse with tailored trousers/ smart jeans or a skirt.

Occasionally, for certain special evening functions, men may be required to wear a jacket and tie.


