

BIRDIE & PAR CUPS

These are awarded for the highest number of gross birdies/pars achieved in qualifying competitions during the 'Bungay Ladies' golfing year' (1 October to 30 September).

Two Birdie Cups were first presented in 1997 by Mrs Jean Webster, who was Ladies' Captain in 1997, one for Silver Division players and one for Bronze Division players.

In 2006 the Jenny Edmonds Par Cup was added to this section. Jenny was Ladies' Captain in 1990 and the cup was originally given for a high handicap knockout.

Birdie Cup (Jean Webster)

This is open to ladies whose handicap index is in the **+5-17.4 range**.

Birdies are awarded 1 point, eagles 2 points and albatrosses 3 points.

Par/Birdie Cup (Jean Webster)

This is open to ladies whose handicap index is in the **17.5-24.2 range**.

Pars are awarded 1 point, birdies 2 points, eagles 3 points and albatrosses 4 points.

The Jenny Edmonds Par Cup

This is open to ladies whose handicap index is in the **24.3-54.0 range**.

Pars are awarded 1 point, birdies 2 points, eagles 3 points and albatrosses 4 points.

Notes:

- In the event of a tie the winner is calculated on stroke indexes (18 points for a par or birdie achieved on the most difficult hole (Stroke Index 1), reducing to 1 point for a par or birdie achieved on the easiest hole (Stroke Index 18).
- If a par or birdie is achieved by a lady in a competition from which she is later disqualified, the par/birdie becomes invalid.
- If a lady moves from one Division to another during the course of the year, the par/birdies achieved are calculated in the Division in which they were achieved.
- These cups are presented at the Ladies' AGM.
