#### OUT OF BOUNDS (OB)(Rule 18.2a)

The course boundary is defined by white stakes / fence posts.

9<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup> holes - a ball ending **on/over** the driveway/carpark is OB, even if it lies on a part of the course that is in bounds for other holes. The practice ground to the left of the **1**<sup>st</sup> fairway is part of the general area of the course. Practice is allowed there before competitions.

## **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** (GUR)(Rule 16.1)

Any area defined with a white line by the committee - areas of bare earth are not automatically GUR unless marked as such.

A ball which is lying in a drainage channel **and** is clearly sitting on exposed gravel, stones or concrete may be classified as being in GUR.

#### **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 16.1)

All man made fixtures (eg constructed tracks, paths, signs, bridges, benches etc.) are deemed immovable obstructions.

### NO PLAY ZONES (Rule 16.1f)

Relief **must** be take taken if a ball lies such that a staked/white banded tree or its protective screen interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing. (There is no relief solely for line of sight interference.)

The island within the penalty area on the  $4^{th}/13^{th}$ .

# SUSPENSION OF PLAY (Rule 5.7b)

A dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged note of the siren. All play must cease immediately in that circumstance.

### PRIORITY ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> TEE

Players continuing after 9 holes have prority as long as:

- i) They have reserved a tee time for the 2<sup>nd</sup> 9.
- ii) Play is continuous.

They do not have priority over a Competition or Society booking.

# WARNINGS - PLEASE NOTE ALL WARNING SIGNS & BE AWARE WHEN PLAYING NEAR PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

1<sup>st</sup> /10<sup>th</sup> Driveway/Public Footpath crosses in front of tee.

2<sup>nd</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> Public Footpath all along the left side of hole. Players on 2<sup>nd</sup> green have priority over those on 9<sup>th</sup> Tee.

3<sup>rd</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> Players crossing fairway from 5<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> tee have priority. Public Footpath crosses in front of 12<sup>th</sup> tee

**4<sup>th</sup>/13<sup>th</sup>** When leaving the green, follow the grass path along the river edge to 5<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> tee.

5<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> Please ring bell to indicate you have cleared the fairway

**6<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>** Beware players emerging on left from 7<sup>th</sup> green. Please ring bell to indicate you have cleared the fairway. Players on 7<sup>th</sup> tee have priority when approaching green.

**8**th/**17**th Public footpath all along the right side of hole.

**9<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup>** Public Footpath crosses in front of blue/yellow tee and in front of green. Players on 2<sup>nd</sup> green have priority over those on 9th Tee.
