Bunker Work

Bunker edge re-turfing is going well with the following bunkers now completed. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 7th, 10th greenside, 10th fairway bunker short of the road. 2 bunkers on the 8th are also finished with the righthand side bunker still with a bit of work to be done.

Hopefully if the weather is ok, we will get the last few bunkers completed this week.

1st Fairway Drainage

As many of you will know, last winter the 1st fairway got very wet across the top and down the left side. During the summer we dug out a section of open ditch in the rough just off the right of the fairway, this was to replace a section of drainage pipe that was blocked from tree roots. This has worked in drying up this area and we now plan to turf the banks of the ditch to improve how it looks. We have now extended this open ditch up and around the top of the fairway, this will catch run-off water from the land above the first tee and therefore help to keep the top of the fairway nice and dry during the winter months. A small bridge will be built over the ditch so the pathway can be extended and directed over to the left of the fairway to give more options to direct traffic.
