

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP SALVER for the lowest gross score over 36 holes (scratch). The Salver was provided in 1983 from the Ladies' prize fund.

36 hole EG Medal, Maximum handicap index: 31

In the event of a tie for the Club Championship Salver, the winner will be determined by a **sudden death play-off**, starting at the first hole, which will take place following play on the day of the event.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP CUP for the lowest nett score over 36 holes. The Cup was provided from the Ladies' prize fund in 1983.

36 hole EG Medal, Maximum handicap index: 31

In the event of a tie for the Club Championship Cup, the winner will be determined by **countback on the last 18 holes and, if still a tie, on the last 9 holes.**

Notes:

- If the winner of the Championship Salver has the Lowest Nett Score, she shall also win the Club Championship Cup.
- Prizes should be awarded in this order:
 - Lowest Gross Score
 - Lowest Nett Score
 - 2nd Lowest Gross Score
 - Best following Lowest Nett Scores
 - Best AM Round and Best PM Round(It is important that the actual positions the players have achieved are published, regardless of the prizes that they have won.)
