# **Captains Report**

BB gave a resume of the results of inter club matches played to date he had previously circulated. He is very happy with the numbers of Seniors wishing to enter and the general camaraderie at the matches. The results are going surprisingly well with a double already achieved against Colchester.

BB spoke about an issue with two Seniors who were unhappy not to have been picked for Inter Club Matches (IC).

One is a new member who, at the time of complaining, had not played in any Senior's matches and therefore was not registered. It was explained to him the criteria for playing in an IC match and he said he only wanted to play in two away matches anyway. It was pointed out that due to the number of Seniors wishing to partake he cannot pick and choose which IC match he plays in. It was also pointed out that is expected that players in away matches should make themselves available for the home match.

The other Senior claimed to have been ignored for IC matches.BB had checked the IC match records for this season and they showed the Senior in question had not entered his name on any entry sheet published to date.

BB advised he will be unavailable to represent the Seniors in two matches in September. Vice-Captain TH will stand in for him.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Board may have heard a rumour that we had received an invitation from Colne Valley to enter a team in their Open Competition Event. The Committee decided not to take up the offer. This is not unusual as we receive such invitations on a regular basis from many other clubs in the area and often decline to enter. In fact we have since heard the Committee's judgement was entirely vindicated when two other local Golf Clubs – Colchester and Felixstowe Ferry – entered and then withdrew from the same event.

The committee will write a letter to the Board to ask for a full retraction of this untrue and misleading allegation from the Board minutes
