Dress Code

Ashford Manor Golf Club has a modern, relaxed approach to dress code and wishes to provide an environment where members, their families & guests together with club visitors are made to feel genuinely welcome and comfortable.

Dress both on and off the course should be respectable and provide a smart appearance.

Players are to use the changing/locker rooms for the changing of shoes and clothing. When necessary please use the cloakroom for coats.

Golf shoes and golfing attire is required to be worn by all players. Golfing attire means clothing that is suitable for golf and is generally available or similar to that which can be purchased in professional's shops or other such outlets including online. If a similar style of clothing can be bought in the pro shop then it may be worn

No denim jeans are permitted to be worn on the golf course.

Golf shoes, hard and soft spiked plus no spikes are permitted. Junior boys/girls under the age of 18 may wear trainers.

Smart, clean dry clothing.

Golf footwear is not permitted in the Lounge and Dining Room but may be worn in the Harold Hilton Bar (Spike Bar).

No headwear is permitted to be worn within any area of the Club House.

General

This dress code applies to everyone. Persons who are considered to be not suitably dressed will be requested to leave the Club. Please avoid embarrassment by respecting the game and AMGC by dressing in the appropriate manner.

Mobile phones should be on silent mode. They can be used for data purposes in and around the club house. Use for voice purposes is limited to outside the Club House but away from the patio and course areas and in the locker/changing room. Please be considerate.

Upon Arrival

- The gates will open automatically when entering the Club
- Please use the car park just inside the front gates on the left-hand side
- Once parked up please report to the Pro Shop, which is signposted from the car park, to check in and pay your green fees. The Pro Shop Team will issue you with a visitor bag tag to show the starter and marshals.
- If you require a buggy, please reserve one in advance.

Practice Facilities

- We have a practice putting green and chipping green located by the 1st tee.
- There is a Golf Pod, which visitors can use before their game to warm up, balls are already located in the pod for you. We have 4 bays available.

Course Information

- The 1st hole is a cross hole with the 8th hole. Golfers teeing off the 1st hole have priority over those playing the 8th hole.
- Please ensure you repair your pitch marks on the greens and replace divots
- When playing the 7th hole if your ball goes beyond boundary line on the right hand side please report this immediately with the Pro Shop.
- When playing the 8th hole please ensure you give priority to those teeing off on the 1st hole.
- When playing the 13th hole if your ball goes beyond boundary line on the right hand side please report this immediately with the Pro Shop.

Food & Beverage Information

- There is a halfway house facility just after the 8th hole. You can pre order from the 7th tee and collect your refreshments once you reach the halfway house. The halfway house is open 7 days a week from 7.30am.
- The Bar will open at 10am and closes at 10pm in the summer and 9pm in the winter.
- The Kitchen will open at 10am and closes at 6pm in the summer and 5pm in the winter.

Social Distancing Restrictions – currently in place

- Please do not remove the flags from the hole on the greens. The hole cups have a liner inserted in them to ensure you do not touch the flag when retrieving your golf ball.
- There are limited bins on the course so please retain any rubbish in your golf bag.
- There is a halfway house service between the 8th and 9th holes. Please ensure you maintain social distancing around this area.
- Food and Beverage is operating as normal.

Clubhouse

- The locker rooms are open for visitors to change shoes and golf clothing before commencing golf.
- There are toilet facilities located on both Men's and Ladies Locker Rooms
- Please obtain the door code from the Pro Shop

After your round

- Once you have completed your round please ensure you check the dress code for the lounge.
- Golf Shoes are not permitted in the main lounge but may be worn in the Harold Hilton Bar (Spike Bar).
- You will require a gate code to exit the Golf Club, please obtain this from the Pro Shop.
