



FIFE JUNIOR STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

at KINGHORN GC

Sunday 30th July 2023 (11.00 am start)

- 1 The Championship will be open to amateur golfers who are members of clubs affiliated to Fife Golfing Association and who are under 18 years of age at 00.01 hours on 1st January 2023.
- 2 The Championship will be decided by stroke play over 18 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Ltd. and the local rules as laid down by the host club.
- 3 The winner will be the competitor with the lowest scratch score over 18 holes. In the event of a tie, the Championship, and all other prizes, will be decided by the better inward half, or last 6 holes, or last 3 holes, or last hole as may be necessary.
- 4 Entry forms should contain date of birth details as well as the entrant's CDH number and, along with the entry fee of £5, should be sent to:

- 5 Prizes will be awarded in both Scratch and Handicap sections. The Junior having the lowest scratch round of the day being the Fife Junior Stroke Play Champion. There will also be a prize for the best score by an under-16 year old.
- 6 The Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving any reason for its decision. The Committee's decision on all matters shall be final.

FIFE JUNIOR MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Players with the lowest 8 scratch scores will qualify to compete in the Fife Junior Match Play Championship. This will be played at Kinghorn GC, during the 2 weeks following the Stroke Play, on dates to be decided. Any competitor who cannot take part in the Match Play Championship must indicate this when registering at the Stroke Play Championship.
