Alternatively, a member may upgrade to full membership for the remainder of the year. The cost to upgrade varies depending on the number of months left. Both credit top-ups and upgrading include a fee to ensure that an upgrading member does not benefit from paying less than a full member would for a similar number of rounds played.
