

Gents Senior Open Stableford Cup

This Cup was donated to the Club by the Thomson brothers: Farquhar, John and retired Pro Alistair in 2010. All three brothers were heavily involved with Moray Golf Club from an early age, being Lossie loons.

Farquhar was Captain of the Club 1965-1967, 1977-1978 and the Centenary Year 1989 – 1990. Farquhar was also the Club Champion in 1959, 1961, 1963 and 1964. Farquhar also won the Moray Open in 1962.

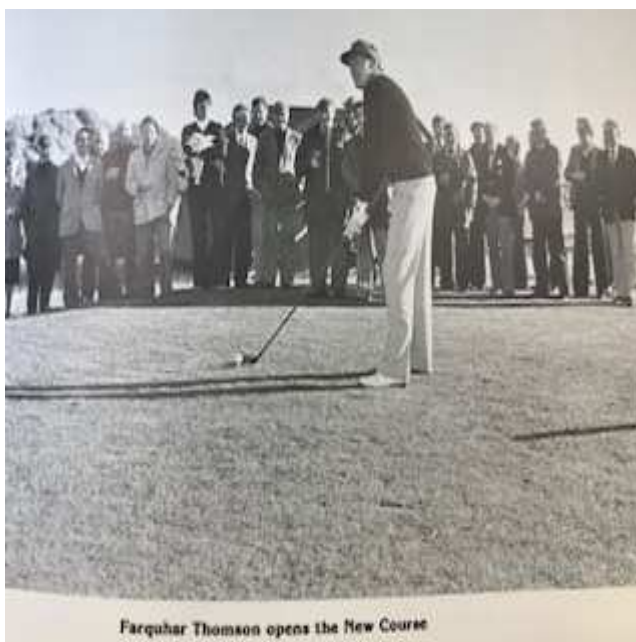
The late John was the middle boy and was a playing member for periods of his life. John was renowned for getting two's and on one occasion shot 36 on the outward 9 on the Old – 666,333,333!

Alistair was the Pro at the Club from 1977 until 2009.

Prior to becoming a Pro Alistair took the Club Champion reign from his brother in 1965 and won it again in 1967, 1972 and 1973. Alistair also won the Moray Open in 1966, 1970 and 1974. As a Pro, Alistair went on to win the North of Scotland Golfers Alliance Championship in the winter of 1987-88.
