

Ellesmere Junior Golf

We are delighted to be able to present below the competitive schedule for the juniors at Ellesmere Golf Club for the 2021 season. We hope you will join us for a great golfing season.

Membership Fees

Currently juniors aged 16-18 pay £100.

Juniors under 16 do not currently pay a membership fee but must pay the affiliation fee:

Boys £13.85 LUGC Affiliation Fee, Girls £14.50 LUGC Affiliation Fee. You may have already received an invoice from the club so please pay this or contact the Ellesmere Secretary to pay your fees so you can enter the competitions: honsec@ellesmeregolfclub.co.uk

Handicap Indexes

In addition to the junior competitions, we will be encouraging the juniors to complete handicap qualifying rounds to gain an official handicap index. Club members or juniors with a handicap index can mark the cards of other juniors who are in the process of gaining a handicap index.

Older boys usually play from the Yellow tees and older girls play from the Red tees. However, it has been agreed that both boys and girls at Ellesmere Golf Club will have the opportunity to play from the Red tees for competitions and for handicap purposes if they are not yet able to achieve a handicap index from the Yellow tees for the boys. As soon as they are able, the boys will play from the Yellow tees.

It has been confirmed that all juniors are able to obtain a handicap index by submitting 3x18 hole scorecards played from the Yellow or Red tees but juniors are also now able to submit 6x9 hole scorecards played from the Yellow or Red tees which is a new option available to Ellesmere Juniors. The options above can be combined - for example 1x18 holes and 4x9 hole scorecards can be handed in to the Ellesmere Pro Shop when you have all of your required scorecards marked. The younger junior golfers will be playing from the Blue tees and won't be able to attain an official handicap index yet but we will allocate them an informal handicap index. We are happy to explain if you don't understand the above detail.

Parent/Carer-Led On Course Supervision: Polite Notice To Parents/Carers

If your child is old enough and/or experienced enough to be out on the golf course and can mark their own scorecard then they will not require any parental supervision.

All inexperienced juniors must be accompanied on the golf course by an adult with parental responsibility. The golf course can be a hazardous place at times so parents should be aware that they are responsible for their own child's safety. Parents/Carers will be required to get involved in your child's golf development and will be required to mark scorecards and learn how the golf scoring system works. As parent volunteers, the junior organisers are DBS checked but they are not responsible for your junior.

Competitions

Each junior will pay £3 to enter every competition. Juniors with a handicap index will be eligible to win the trophies for the competitions – playing from either the Yellow or Red tees. Prize vouchers/items from the Ellesmere Pro Shop will be offered to the winners. Other prizes will be offered to the juniors who have yet to gain an official handicap index if they win their designated competition (9 hole, 4 hole).

Presentations

A short presentation will take place following each competition and there will be a Presentation Evening following the Junior Club Championship event where all trophies will be presented officially by Mr Captain.

Booking Your Junior Competition Place Using BRS

To enter junior competitions, it will be necessary for all players or parents to book onto the online booking system BRS. BRS is the golf app where you can book a tee time at the golf club.

Firstly, go to Ellesmere Golf Club website - www.ellesmeregolfclub.co.uk

Scroll down to Book a Tee Time, Choose Member Booking

Click Register if you haven't already registered. Enter details. Login if you have already registered.

Your 4 digit member number will have been given to you when you paid your fees. If you don't know it, click forgot Username/Password or please ask us if you're struggling. Once you have registered or logged in you can access the junior competition dates and can book your tee time **2 weeks** before the competition. Once registered on the club website, you can download the BRS app on your device.

It is your responsibility to book your own competition tee time. Book a time and fill up the tee sheet by joining with other juniors who are booked in against the competition you want to enter. **3 juniors per tee time only please.** The first three competitions have been set as 9 hole trophy competitions as the golf club tee sheet is busy with other competitions so we are easing everyone in with 9 and 4 holes to start with. The fourth competition onwards will include an 18 hole competition. An 18 hole competition will take approximately 4 hours so the juniors in this competition will book the first junior tee times which have been allocated. Around 1.5 hours after that, the 9 hole competitors will book on followed by the 4 hole competitors. Times may alter slightly due to demand.
