#### **Finance**

Turnover for the year to 28 February was £1,120,000 compared to the budget of £1,092,000, which is favourable by £28k. This is due to higher green fees, society and open competition income and new members fees, offset by lower property rental income. Net Profit post VAT for the year was £9,000 compared to budgeted loss of £3,000, favourable by £12,000.

**Budgets for 2023/2024 year** being prepared and will be presented now at the April Board Meeting.

### Greens

**Greens** - Greens over the last 3 months have been showing high levels of disease pressure, we have sprayed a preventative fungicide, which due to recent regulation changes is weaker than that of years past. Whilst it has reduced the amount of outbreak it has not been fully effective. Previously we have had a 'contact' fungicide which can stop the disease in its tracks at first sign of attack. This unfortunately is no longer allowed by law.

**Fairways** - Once weather allows, we will complete more verti-draining on fairways. We have already done this once and a 2<sup>nd</sup> time will be required to combat standing water and hopefully allow them to become more free draining. When springtime arrives, we will be applying a heavy topdressing on all fairways. This will also be done around October 2023 weather depending. This will dilute the amount of pure soil the worms cast onto the surface by increasing the sand levels in the profile. This will

hopefully be the start of a long-term program allowing us to be in a better position to remove wormcasts easily and cleaner in the future.

**Bunkers** - The new bunker lining on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> has been installed followed by new sand and are open. Over the next few weeks, we will be checking all bunker sand levels, some bunkers will also have a top up of sand. We have reduced the bunker hight on the 12<sup>th</sup> fairway and removed the fairway bunker on the 18<sup>th</sup>. These areas will be turfed very soon.
