

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

The locker room is for the use of all members and as such the responsibility is on every member to maintain a safe, clean and healthy environment for everyone, it is important to abide by the rules listed.

Players are advised to place all valuables in their locker and ensure the locker is securely locked prior to leaving the locker room. Airdrie Golf Club is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

No food or drink should be consumed in the locker room. For safety reasons glass is prohibited.

Please respect other member's privacy, the use of visual recording equipment is prohibited.

All clothing and equipment must be placed in a locker. Damp clothing, shoes and towels should not be stored in your locker. Please take these home to dry off.

Golf trollies are not permitted in the locker room.

Golf shoes should not be stored under the benches.

Do not leave golf equipment in the locker room overnight. If it doesn't go in your locker, take it home.

Any rubbish should be disposed of in the bin provided outside the locker room, next to the pro shop.

Members may only share a locker with the prior approval of the Locker Convenor. This will be logged and all keys (including copies) must be returned when giving up lockers.

In exceptional circumstances Airdrie Golf Club reserve the right to open and inspect lockers.
