Finance

Turnover for the year to 31 July was £469,000 compared to the budget of £432,000, which is favourable by £37k. This is mainly due to higher green fees (actual £40,000 compared to budget of £23,000 – favourable by £17,000) and bar income favourable by £9,000. Net loss post VAT for the year to 31 July was £3k compared to budget loss of £10k, which is favourable by £7k. This is due to higher income offset by timing differences on Cost of Sales and Admin Costs. The net cash movement for the year was (£1,000) compared to the budget of £2,000, which is adverse by £3k. The CAPEX costs relate to the purchase of a new printer and also for additional costs for the bunker work that we assumed they had included in last year but did not. The higher VAT non recoverable is due to the VAT associated with the new greens equipment purchased on HP in the 1st quarter.

Other Key Highlights - Turnover for the Bar for in the month was £38,000 compared to £37,000 and £32,000 for the prior 2 months and £30,000 last year. This was the highest monthly bar takings for last few years. Golf society fee and green fee income for the month was £10,000 compared to £11,000 in the previous month and £6k last year.

Course: Greens & Tees - Growth on greens is still continuing to flourish given the temperatures and amount of rainfall were getting. We plan to spray a growth regulator to greens next week. We are aware of the fairy ring activity on the greens. As holes are being changed, we have a member of staff hand dressing these areas out in attempt to improve the surface. This week we have been double cutting greens followed by a roll.

Tees - From Monday we have started the maintenance program to tee tops, this process consists of coring/seeding/dressing followed by a granular feed to help with the continued high levels of golf and divot activity. We are divotting tees daily but the rate of seed germination sometimes cannot keep up with the rate of play.

Fairways - Growth rate is still high as is the rest of the course. We are mowing 3-4 times a week, sometimes double cutting on particular days. We have applied a weed/feed to the fairways, a second app maybe needed.

Bunkers - Since Wednesday this week we have changed how we rake the bunkers, this will hopefully improve playability and stop the bounce affect. This will be monitored going forward.

Captain's Committee/Social

Social functions continue to be supported well and lots of planning for upcoming events ongoing.

Membership

Interviews continue for both playing and social members. Strong waiting list with golfers and non-golfers wanting to join the club. Review of Junior memberships re: offering and numbers ongoing.

Projects

Still actively trying to sell the properties, progressing. 13th Hole project also moving forward to planning stage – preliminary designs and drawing put up on foyer noticeboard.

Admin

Membership numbers and applications remain strong with sub-committee meetings ongoing to support the work of the board. Documentation publication/distribution and administration ahead of the 2023 AGM ongoing.
