

## DRESS CODE POLICY

Members, Guests and Visitors are respectfully requested to follow our dress code.  
In simple terms a clean, smart standard of dress is expected both on the course and in the clubhouse and the following table gives specific guidelines

Following such a request, any Member or guest refusing to comply may result in Staff or Directors asking the individual to leave the Clubhouse or Course. Any persistent breaches of the dress code should be reported to the Club Secretary who will take appropriate action.
