CALCULATING COUNTBACKS IN COMPETITIONS

Should a tie result in either a strokeplay or stableford competition the winner(s) and subsequent placings will be decided on countback of score or points. For a scratch competition (i.e. no handicaps) the gross scores should be used. For a handicap competition (i.e. with handicaps) the net scores should be used. For stableford competition the stableford points should be used. The countback is calculated as follows:

1	The last 9 holes of the course
2	The last 6 holes of the course
3	The last 3 holes of the course
4	The last hole of the course
5	The last 2 holes of the course
6	The last 4 holes of the course
7	The last 5 holes of the course
8	The last 7 holes of the course
9	The last 8 holes of the course
10	The last 10 holes of the course
11	The last 11 holes of the course
12	The last 12 holes of the course
13	The last 13 holes of the course
14	The last 14 holes of the course
15	The last 15 holes of the course
16	The last 16 holes of the course
17	The last 17 holes of the course
18	By lot

Countback is always made in the way described above regardless of which hole the players started from.

Peculiarities and Ties:-

Bingo Bango Bongo is a fun game where there is no need to worry about handicaps or how many shots it takes to get close to the green. There are 3 points available on each hole.

- The first player to hit their shot onto the green gets a point (Bingo)
- The player whose ball is closest to the pin when all balls are on the green gets a point (Bango)
- The first player to hole out gets a point (Bongo).

Ready golf is played until any player is in a position to take a shot to the green, then the player who is furthest from the green always takes their shot first, followed by the next furthest away to completion of that hole.

When playing a par 3, the winner of the last hole takes the first shot so that person has the opportunity of being on the green first.

As the majority of the field will be 3 balls, if there are only two players, then their scores will be adjusted by 2/3rds for the two players to make it a fair competition against the 3 ball players.

Winners are the pair who take their flag to the furthest point on the course before running out of shots and the pair reaching the second furthest point are the runners up. Winners receive a trophy. Runners-up receive 2 golf balls each.

18 Hole 4BBB Matchplay WHS rules apply to calculate players course handicap. To calculate the shots allowed, take Player's handicap index and calculate their course handicap using the WHS Course Handicap Tables. Shots received are taken from the lowest player and then 90% is deducted from the difference. See example below.

A player has a Handicap Index of 24.9 =Course Handicap 29. The lowest player has a course handicap of 20 so the difference is 9 shots. 90% of 9 = 8.1 rounded down to 8 shots allowed.

Both Clubs will endeavour to match each other's number of players. If in the return match a team is short, then a game has to be given to the Club with a full team The aggregate score of the two matches will decide the winner. If the score is halved, then each Club will hold the shield for six months. The winner of the Trophy pays for the engraving.

The Captains and Vice Captains are to lead the field wherever possible and thereafter the teams will play in handicap order starting with the lowest handicap. Where possible the dates and tee times for the following year are to be made after the last match (To be confirmed). The organiser for the year will be decided by the current Lady Captain.

COASTAL BELLES TROPHY – INTER-CLUB MATCH

Competition:

This competition is played off 100% handicap with 8 lady players from each Club. Each tee slot will be made up of one player from each club who will play a single stableford round of 18 holes. The six best stableford scores from each Club will be aggregated and the Club with the highest aggregate stableford score will win the trophy.

The winning club will hold the Coastal Belles Trophy for the year until the next competition. The winning club is responsible for the cost of engraving.

Background:

Ex Lady Captain 2016 Gilly Cullen along with her counterpart Lady Captains from Harwich & Dovercourt & Frinton founded a triangular competition rotating each year to host an 18-hole single stableford competition between ladies from Clacton, Frinton and Harwich & Dovercourt Golf Clubs.

ENGLAND GOLF - THE RACE TO WOODALL SPA

Background:-

This competition has replaced the England Women's Medal Competition and from 2023 it has been rebranded as a mixed event named "The Race to Woodall Spa 2023". Once the report has been downloaded from the England Golf site, the club will be able to enter their men's and women's club winner.

All 18-hole, individual handicap qualifying, club competitions played throughout the year will determine the club winner who qualifies to enter for a place in an Area Final.

Players who qualify from their club can select which one of the 10 venues across the country they would like to enter. If a chosen Area Final is over-subscribed, players may be offered either a place on the reserve list or a place at an alternative venue where possible.
