



Handicaps and Playing In Competition

Gaining And Retaining A Handicap

In order to play in competitions and matches you will require a handicap.

To gain a handicap you need to put in three cards of 18 holes, or 6 cards of 9 holes or a mixture of the two to equate to 54 holes.

Cards should be marked by another player and should have your name, date played, and for handicap purposes marked on the card. Cards must be signed by yourself and the marker.

Gents to put completed cards in the box under the PSI.

To retain a handicap you need to play in three qualifying competitions between 1st January and 31st December each year. Alternatively you can put in a supplementary card. If you are submitting a supplementary card you need to pay in the Pro shop and sign the supplementary book before commencing play. Your completed card must be returned and put into the relevant box.

Entering Competitions

Competitions for gents and mixed competitions can be entered on howdidido, the PSI in the foyer or through the Pro shop. If you are not registered on howdidido go to www.howdidido.com and register. If you have difficulty in registering or need any help in entering competitions when you have registered please contact the office and speak to Judith or Marie or the Pro shop.

Dates that competitions have to be entered by may vary so please check e:mails and information on notice boards.

As a general rule dates to enter competitions are as follows:

Drawn gents competitions need to be entered by the Thursday before the date of the competition. Latest time to enter is 5.00pm

Gents roll up competitions do not need to be entered pay entry fee in the Pro shop on the day of the competition

Gents non drawn competitions can be entered up to the day of the competition on howdidido, the Psi or in the Pro shop.
