

GOLFER OF THE YEAR (HODGSON ROSEBOWL)

Presented by Mrs L Hodgson in 1971. 'Tiny' was a longstanding member and Ladies' Captain from 1948-1950 and 1970 and 1971 and Honorary Secretary from 1929-1939.

Presented to the player who has accumulated the most points during the year for nominated qualifying competitions.

Points are awarded for the first 5 places in the following competitions:

Notes:

- **** Eclectic:** The points will be awarded for the best 5 places taken from an overall list of competitors in all three handicap categories (Silver, Bronze A and Bronze B).
- There must be a minimum of 12 entries in each competition before points are awarded for 'Golfer of the Year', with the exception of the Club Championship Salver and the Club Championship Cup.
- In the event of a tie, the joint winners will share the Rosebowl.
