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NOTES FOR VISITING SOCIETIES

In connection with the visit of your Society, please complete the enclosed forms and return to the Club along with your deposit to secure your booking.

Your attention is drawn to the following conditions that must be strictly observed. In particular Thorpe Hall Golf Club expects the Society Organiser to take responsibility for the conduct of his members and that they are made aware of the Club's requirements.

1. Societies can only be accepted with a minimum number of 12 and a maximum of 36 participants unless specifically negotiated.
2. A non-refundable deposit of £200 is required when booking forms are returned.
3. Provisional booking will be held open for 30 days. The booking will be confirmed only after the deposit and completed paperwork has been received.
4. Any changes to the numbers in the Society must be confirmed 5 days prior to the visit and the number given will be the minimum catered for and charged.
5. Members of the Society, who are also playing members of Thorpe Hall Golf Club, do not pay a green fee, but they cannot introduce Society non-members at the reduced "playing with a member" green fee.
6. Breakfast, lunch and evening meals will be served in the restaurant, where smart casual dress is acceptable.
7. Please refer to the enclosed dress code and ensure that all Society members understand and comply with our dress requirements both on and off the course.
8. On your arrival, a member of our team will welcome you and do whatever they can to ensure your day is as perfect as we can make it.
9. The society organiser should provide the names and handicaps of all players before play commences.

Your feedback is key to our continued improvement. Any correspondence received by the club regarding your society day may be used in future promotion campaigns or marketing of the club.

We trust in your compliance with the above requirements when we will do all we can to ensure your society has an enjoyable day here at Thorpe Hall.

Welcomes **Correctly Dressed Golfers**

Thorpe Hall Golf Club extends a warm welcome to all visitors and hope that you have a memorable golfing experience.

Please read the information below with regard to dress code on the Course and in the Clubhouse.

On the Course, the following clothing is permitted:

- Weather protective clothing, specifically designed for golf
- Accredited golf polo shirts or roll necked shirts
- Accredited golf footwear and trousers or smart chinos
- Knee length tailored shorts, worn with plain white socks either normal or sports socks.
- Ladies clothing designed to be worn untucked is permitted.

On the course, the following dress is NOT permitted.

- Blue denim, combat trousers or cargo style shorts
- Polo shirts or roll necked shirts worn untucked.

In the Clubhouse, the following dress is permitted:

- Accredited golf shirts, roll necks or collared shirts.
- Trousers or knee length tailored shorts, worn with knee length or white sports socks.
- Smart jeans (not bleached, cut, ripped or baggy).
- Leisure / deck shoes (socks optional).
- Clean, spike-less golf shoes may be worn in the spike bar only.

In the Clubhouse, the following dress is not permitted:

- Rainwear, hats, caps or visors
- Combat trousers
- Men's open toed footwear
- Wet or muddy clothing or shoes
- Any type of hi vis clothing

In the dining room, smart casual dress (including smart jeans) is required after 6pm and Sunday lunchtime.

The changing of clothing or footwear in the car park is not permitted, visitors are asked to use the changing rooms provided. The code for entry into the changing rooms can be obtained from the office, pro shop or bar.

Mobile Phones/Laptops

Mobile phones may not be used on the golf course, except in the case of a medical emergency. Inside the clubhouse, mobiles should be kept on silent at all times, voice calls may only be made from the lobby, changing rooms or car park area. Mobile phones and laptops (on silent) may be used in the mixed lounge for the purpose of sending and receiving text messages and emails only.

Members are encouraged to share the above guidelines with their guests.
